Inspired by Girl In Red's '4AM', this supplement aims to add a mechanical benefits for thinking too much again in the ungodly hours of the morning. At the cost of -1 to all volatile rolls for that day, as your character is exhausted and therefore unable to react as quickly, you can gain the following benefits:

Turn Someone On

When you lay awake at night thinking about someone they're attracted to, you carry 1 forward to winning that person's attention, as well as a +1 to all rolls to turn them on. However, if you admit that you lay awake all night thinking of them, you take a -1 to your next roll to turn them on and gain the condition 'Weirdo'.

Shut Someone Down

When you lay awake at night imagining potential arguments with a person, gain a +1 to any attempts to shut them down. However, if they react the opposite to the way you expect, you take a -1 to your next attempt to shut them down.

Gaze Into The Abyss

When you lay awake at night thinking, you can roll to GAZE INTO THE ABYSS. On a 10+ the abyss shows you lucid visions, and you take 1 forward to addressing them. On a 7-9, you fall asleep and the abyss shows you visions with "dream logic". On a 2-6, you fall asleep and have normal dreams, but you don't take a -1 to your volatile rolls that day.
